



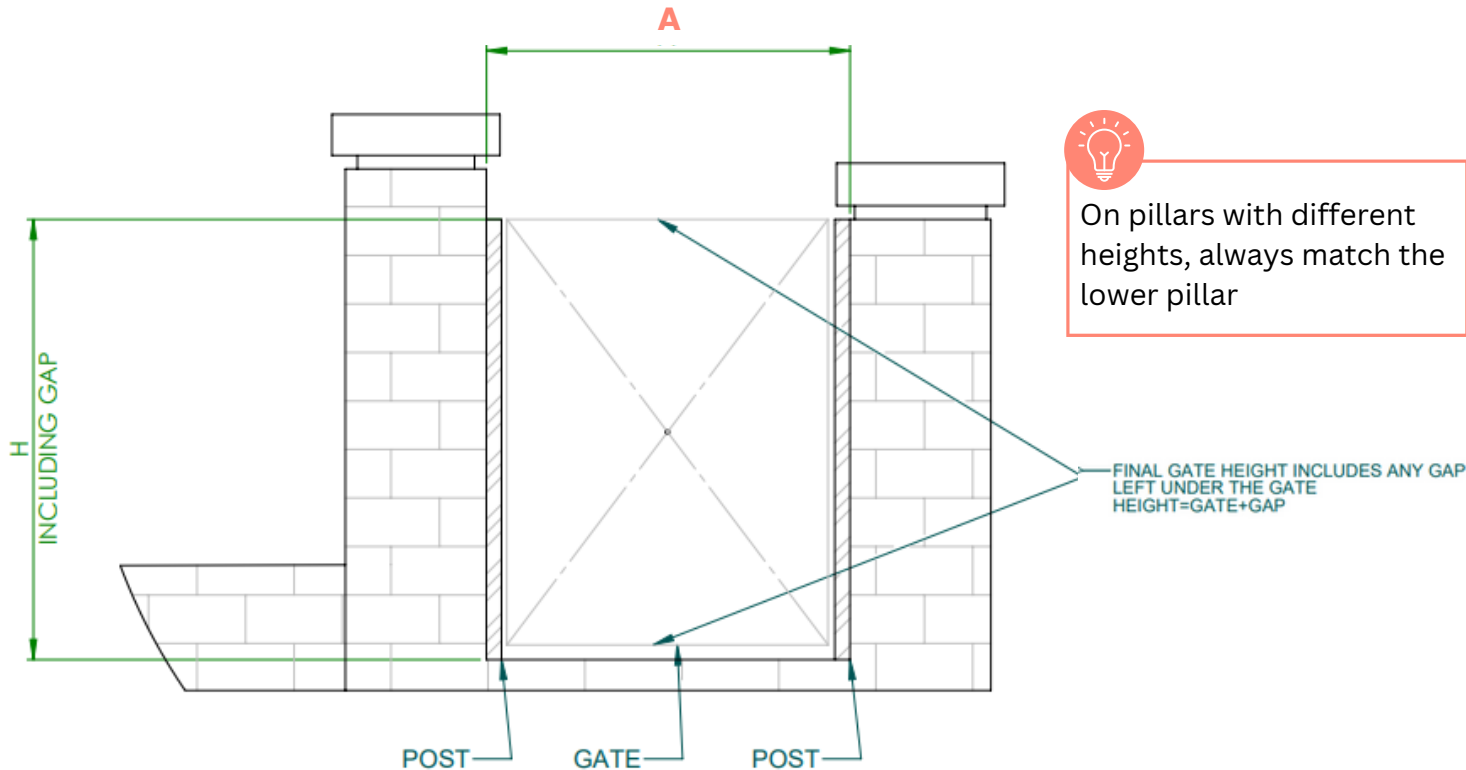
Pedestrian Gate measuring guide

A. How to measure pedestrian gates:

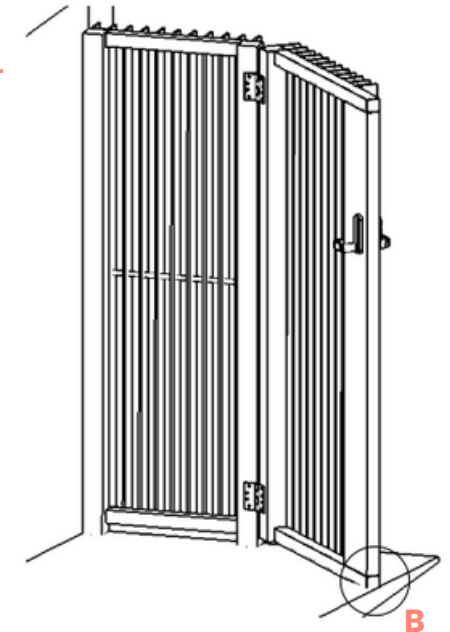
- Pedestrian gates look best dressed in a hinge post and a catch post
- Decide which way the gate will swing: Left or right. Also define direction: Inwards or outwards
- Make sure you allow for hinge and latch gaps. Also allow a sufficient gap under the gate for opening



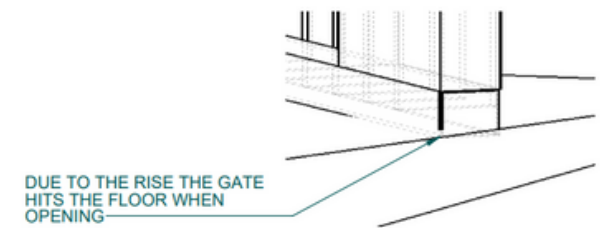
If you are walking up a rise and through a gate, your gate will need enough gap to clear the floor when open. Otherwise, it will hit the floor when opening



On pillars with different heights, always match the lower pillar
